Great news broke this week that Mullinahone Community Council were successful in their application for funding to provide a community based digital hub, which once delivered will help to support locals hoping to work from home where perhaps broadband is not good enough or students need a quieter space to study.

€95,000 has been approved for the project.

Now that funding has been approved, it's early in the planning stage but the broad idea is to repurpose /refit the 2 rooms behind the stage for use as a Digital Hub.
